Dudley is a large town located in the heart of the Black Country in the West Midlands, 10 miles west of Birmingham, 6 miles from Wolverhampton and 3 miles from junction 2 M5, 6 miles (9.7 km) south-east of Wolverhampton and 10.5 miles (16.9 km) north-west of Birmingham. The town is the administrative centre of the Metropolitan Borough of Dudley. The Metropolitan Borough, which includes the towns of Stourbridge and Halesowen, has a population of 312,900. Dudley is sometimes called the capital of the Black Country.



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
